The Pasty is a folded pastry that began in Cornwall, England. The first recipe dates back to 1300 but they were most famously made by the female mine maidens for the miners of Cornwall. The miners could take the Pasties down into the mine and hold them along the crust. Most Cornish Pasties are made with whatever is available and have been a dish served to the highest of royalty as well as the average people of classical Europe.
